HOLLYWOOD HAS ITS OWN FILM OFFICE - FINALLY

With 15 film commissions in Los Angeles County alone and close to 80 in the state of California, it is hard to imagine that Hollywood is just now getting its own film office.

HOLLYWOOD CA, February 29, 2008: For a town synonymous with movie making it seems only natural that there would be a company whose main purpose is to facilitate that process. The Hollywood Film Office officially opened its doors with this specific goal in mind. As a motion picture production services company, HFO offers cost effective studio support to independent filmmakers.

Indie film producer Bruce Wayne Gillies runs the Hollywood Film Office and plans to be a major proponent of filmmaking in the Los Angeles County area; championing the local industry as a viable, reasonable, and affordable alternative to runaway production. In addition, HFO will maintain a booth for the very first time at the Location Trade Show Expo in Santa Monica, CA this coming April 10-12 2008. HFO intends to raise awareness of the important role the film industry plays in Los Angeles and its history with an open invitation to production, both domestic and international to roll sound and cameras here in Hollywood.

Most notably, the Hollywood Film Office opening announcement coincides with a historic celebration of the *100th Anniversary of movie making in Los Angeles (1908-2008)*! The first movie produced in L.A. was in 1908 by the Selig-Polyscope Co.; *IN THE SULTAN'S POWER* was made from their downtown L.A. studio. Amazingly this highly important event almost slipped by, until now. In response, the Hollywood Film Office is celebrating this monumental occasion and planning a huge celebration this summer: The Hollywood Film Office Grand Opening / 100th Anniversary of movie making in LA, coming soon.

With its streamlined approach to the physical production aspects of independent filmmaking, HFO is confident and excited for the future of Hollywood and making movies move.
